

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, December 13th, 2018 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with two councillors absent.

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. with Deputy Reeve Bendtsen presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on November 8th, 2018 were approved as circulated, the minutes of the November 16th, 2018 special meeting were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of November were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council acknowledged the update on 2018 gravel crushing and road improvement projects, appointed the 2019 Board of Revision, acknowledged council indemnity statements for July to December, acknowledged receipt of Border-Line Housing Company representative Ralph White's indemnity for 2018, authorized the tendering of the R.M.'s 2019 gravel hauling and spreading requirements, set holiday hours, and developed a dust control program for 2019.

Council received three delegations, including a presentation from the Lower Souris Watershed Committee Watershed Manager and contractors bestowing Christmas wishes.

Public Works Foreman, Girard, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of way applications were approved by council for wellsites, approach use, pipeline installations, and seismic operations.

Correspondence was received and filed.
