

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 11, 2024 at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all Councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 14th, 2023 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of December was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council accepted a tender for the left-hand snow wings, opted out of the MHI Spring Weight Restriction Program, and acknowledged receipt of the Fidelity Bond. Workers compensation coverage was authorized, and requests for proposals for the supply of diesel fuel and for 2024 gravel hauling and spreading were called. Council agreed to allocate the entire population of the RM to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2024 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Grants were issued to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and the Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery. Contributions to multiple programs and memberships for 2024 in several organizations were approved. Advertising in local school yearbooks was approved.

Public Works Supervisor, Armstrong, and Assistant Public Works Supervisor, Mailhiot, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop.

Two delegations were received.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:05pm.
