

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, August 12, 2021, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with one councillor absent and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 7:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on July 8th, 2021 were approved as circulated. Minutes of Special Meetings held on July 15th, 2021 and July 21st, 2021, were approved as presented. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of July was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized the signing of a lease agreement, supported a ¼ page ad in the Royal Canadian Legion Saskatchewan Command Military Service Recognition Book, and ratified the hiring of a temporary casual public works employee. Council authorized the layoff date for the Seasonal Public Works Employees, and supported a joint letter to the Ministry of Agriculture highlighting drought issues in our area.

Council authorized the Public Works Foreman to direct Public Works Employees to perform mowing and grading for the Village of Alida as time permits. A donation of \$7,500.00 to the Redvers Fire Department was authorized as a contribution to the STARS landing pad. Council declared the Joint Well located at SW 34-06-34 W1 to be not potable as recommended by Public Health and set the September meeting for 7:00 a.m.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

Two road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
