

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, December 11, 2025 at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with one Councillor absent and Division 5 Vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. with Reeve Bendtsen presiding.

Minutes of the November Regular Meeting held on November 13, 2025 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of November was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Jordan Kawecki, Chamney Crushing Ltd., attended the meeting to discuss the municipality's gravel and to extend Christmas Greetings. Public Works Supervisor, Armstrong, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to workshop operation.

Council acknowledged the resignation of Division Five Councillor, Louis Gervais, effective November 25th, 2025. Council set the date for the by-election for Councillor of Division Five for February 25th, 2026.

Council acknowledged the completion of 2025 municipal road improvement projects.

The Board of Revision, Board of Revision Secretary, Development Appeals Board and Development Appeals Board Secretary were appointed for 2026. Council appointed Don Seipp as Weed Inspector, Terry Barnes as Pest Control Officer and Laurie-Anne Rusnak to be the third-party investigator for 2026.

Council authorized renewal of the Coyote Bounty for ratepayers and residents of this municipality to commence January 1, 2026.

Council acknowledged that there were no Accident/Incident Report Forms dated between November 14th, 2025 and December 12th, 2025.

The Council approved a number of road right-of-way applications.

Correspondence was received and filed.
