

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, October 8<sup>th</sup>, 2020, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all councillors present and Division 1 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on September 10<sup>th</sup>, 2020 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of September was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Three delegates were received – salesmen, who discussed graders with council. Council then authorized the purchase of 2 new Caterpillar graders.

Council adopted a revised Tangible Capital Asset Policy and authorized gravel pit measures. Council approved 3 recreation grants and authorized a donation to the Alida Golden Gate Society to assist with expenses. A letter was authorized to be sent to the Canadian Centre for Health and Safety in Agriculture, (U of S), supporting their application to the Canadian Institutes of Health Research for their proposed Saskatchewan Rural Mental Health and Sleep Study.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:40 p.m.
