

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, June 9, 2022, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all Councillors present and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on May 12th, 2022, were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of May was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized the contract and installation of eavestroughs and downspouts for the new cold storage shed, adopted the Division Review Policy, and acknowledged a road closed notice. Council authorized advertising on the RM's Facebook, Twitter and website to inform the public that there would be no hay salvage program for 2022. Council authorized a grant to assist with the 2022 operating costs of the Alida Fire Department. Council authorized a letter to the Fire Chief regarding the Provincial Fire Service Minimum Standards Guide. Council acknowledged the report from the CAO on monitoring and improving the municipality's Asset Management Plan.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop.

One delegation was received.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
