Re-Advertise Full Time Public Works Employee

Resolution No. 102-26	Carlsen: That as the candidates selected for interviews did not attend their interviews, the municipality re-advertise for a Full Time Public Works Employee with a minimum of three (3) years' experience operating a motor grader, start date to be mutually determined, minimum salary of \$67,000, negotiable with further experience, and applications accepted until a suitable candidate is found. <u>Carried</u>

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Sand/Salt Highway Truck

Resolution No. 104-26	Harrison: That the municipality purchase a 2027 Freightliner 114SD Plus with Snowdogg HD Full Trip Municipal Snow Plow, and SaltDogg MDS Combination Dump Spreader from Commercial Truck Equipment Co. Regina, Saskatchewan, at an approximate cost of \$398,500 plus applicable taxes, and any tariffs, surcharges, etc., incurred during the build process. <u>Carried</u>
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Petro-Canada Cardlock Changes

Resolution No. 105-26	Gervais: That with the changes to the Petro-Canada cardlock requiring each card to be tied to a cell phone for providing a unique PIN for each login, the municipality's current cards be allocated to the cell numbers of the Public Works Works Supervisor, the Assistant Public Works Supervisor, and the Administrator, and further, it be the preference of Council that gasoline be procured from Alida Farm & Auto, Alida, Saskatchewan, except in emergency cases. <u>Carried</u>
