

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, January 9<sup>th</sup>, 2020 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on December 12<sup>th</sup>, 2019 were approved as circulated. The Statements of Financial Activities for the month of December were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council acknowledged the resignation of the Division One councillor leaving this division vacant. Council authorized appointments for the 2020 rural municipal elections, authorized workers compensation coverage and set the 2020 wages and salaries. An employee agreement was acknowledged, grants were issued to St. Raphael's Parish Cemetery, the Town of Carnduff Cemetery, and the Dannevirke Lutheran Church Cemetery, and the Fidelity Bond was acknowledged. Council opted out of the MHI Spring Weight Restriction Program and set the dates for the Budget and Ratepayers' Meetings. Contributions to multiple programs and memberships for 2020 in several organizations were approved. A request for proposal for the supply of diesel fuel was called and council authorized a tender for 2020 gravel hauling and spreading. Council agreed to allocate the entire population of the RM to the Village of Alida for funding under the 2021 Community Grant Program for Sport, Culture, and Recreation. Advertising in local school yearbooks was approved and a new Deputy Reeve was appointed to fill the now vacant position.

Two delegations were received – a contractor and a salesman.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved for wellsites, approaches, and powerlines.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
