
BYLAW NO. 12-23

A BYLAW OF THE RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF RECIPROCITY NO. 32 TO ESTABLISH PENALTIES FOR CONTRAVENTION OF BYLAWS

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32 in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw may be referred to as the "General Penalty Bylaw".
2. "Municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32.
3. Section 4 shall apply only with respect to an infraction of a bylaw of the municipality for which no other penalty is provided.
4. Every person who contravenes any provision of any bylaw of the municipality is guilty of an offense and liable of summary conviction:
 - a. in the case of an individual, to a fine not exceeding \$10,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues; and
 - b. in the case of a corporation, to a fine not exceeding \$25,000 and, in the case of a continuing offence, to a further fine not exceeding \$2,500 for each day during which the offence continues.
5. Bylaw No. 2-15 is hereby repealed as the original was lost in the fire March 16, 2022.
6. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of its final passing.
