

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, June 13, 2019 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with one councillor absent.

The meeting was called to order at 8:10 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on May 9th, 2019 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of May were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Gravel crushing of 70,000 yards and an agreement for extraction and stockpiling of gravel for the 2019-2021 seasons was authorized. A 5-year gravel excavation/removal lease agreement was approved. Council postponed a road construction project and entered into an agreement to purchase additional Right of Way. Advertisements were authorized for Facebook/Twitter and the municipal website to inform that the top cut would be starting June 24, 2019 and that there would be no hay salvage program in 2019. A \$5000 grant was approved for the Alida Fire Department to assist with 2019 operating costs. A date was set for the summer barbeque as well as an appreciation potluck barbeque for the Alida Fire Department Volunteer Firefighters. Council acknowledged a road closed notice as well as a road open notice, authorized grader school for the public works employees, authorized payment of fees for an appointment of a commissioner for oaths, appointed the Pest Control Officer, and joined the Resource Communities of Canada Coalition.

One visitor was received.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved for wellsites, approach use, and phonenumber installation.

Correspondence was received and filed.
