

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, June 11th, 2020, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all councillors present and Division 1 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on May 14th, 2020 were approved as circulated. The Statements of Financial Activities for the month of May were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council authorized the ordering of a marker and plaque to commemorate the Nottingham Hamlet site, and authorized advertising on the RM's Facebook, Twitter and website to inform the public that the top cut would begin the week of June 22, 2020 and that there would be no hay salvage program for 2020. Payment of fees for appointing a Commissioner for Oaths was approved, the MEEP 2020 Funding Agreement was signed, and it was decided that the RM would apply under MEEP for funding for the road upgrade project. The engineering proposal to assist in road construction was awarded and council authorized application to the Rural Road Classification System Committee to reclassify a portion of road.

Council authorized a grant to assist with the 2020 operating costs of the Alida Fire Department and approved a ratepayer request to install "Slow Watch for Children" signs in front of their residence. A letter in support SARM's Notice of Objection to the deregistration of strychnine for control of the Richardson's Ground Squirrel was authorized. Council acknowledged the official opening of the office to the public effective June 8, 2020 and the Opening Protocol plan that was enacted.

One delegation was received via electronic means.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved for wellsites, an approach and a pipeline integrity dig.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:10 a.m.
