

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF RECIPROCITY NO. 32

BYLAW NO. 6 - 24

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH AN EMERGENCY MEASURES ORGANIZATION

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. The Council shall establish a Local Emergency Measures Organization to deal with any emergency or disaster that may occur.
2. The Council shall appoint a person as a Local Emergency Measures Co-ordinator; and
3. The Council shall establish a Local Emergency Planning Committee composed of:
 - (a) The Emergency Measures Co-ordinator appointed in clause 2; and
 - (b) Any other persons Council considers necessary.
4. The Emergency Measures Co-ordinator is the Chairperson of the Local Emergency Planning Committee.
5. The Co-ordinator shall have the following duties and responsibilities:
 - (a) acts as Chairman of the Emergency Measures Planning Committee established under this bylaw;
 - (b) stimulates and co-ordinates the development of an emergency plan for the community in co-operation with the departments and agencies of the municipality;
 - (c) provides emergency plans from guidelines laid down by the Emergency Measures Control Group;
 - (d) submits regular reports to the Emergency Measures Control Group to keep them fully informed of progress;
 - (e) correlates all activities of those persons and/or organizations involved within the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32 and designated for Emergency Measures Organizations;
 - (f) ensures that a continuous program of training for Local Emergency Measures Organization personnel is carried out, either by local training classes or attendance at provincial or federal training schools;
 - (g) co-operates with the Mutual Aid Area and Saskatchewan Emergency Planning on all matters pertaining to planning and operations;
 - (h) submits a projected budget to cover costs of emergency measures operations within the municipality;
 - (i) acts as advisor to the Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32 during emergencies or disasters.
6. The Rural Municipality of Reciprocity No. 32 shall provide funding as deemed necessary and appropriate in the establishment and maintenance of the Emergency Measures Organization.
7. The Council may enter into agreements with other municipalities for the purpose of jointly establishing and operating a Mutual Aid Area.



8. Bylaw 2-03 is hereby repealed as the original was lost in the fire March 16, 2022.
9. This Bylaw shall come into force and take effect upon the day of its final passing.
