

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, June 12, 2025, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with one Councillor absent.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00am with Reeve Bendtsen presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on May 8, 2025, were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of May was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council withdrew their previous road name request of "Nottingham Road" at the recommendation of the Ministry of Highways, set the date for the 2025 budget meeting, and acknowledged numerous road closed/open notices. Council authorized a donation to the Bow Valley Villa and a grant to the Village of Alida for the Alida Fire Department operating costs. Council reaffirmed their commitment to the Border-Line Housing Company New Kitchen Project and increased recreation grant amounts for 2025.

Public Works Supervisor, Armstrong, and Assistant Public Works Supervisor, Mailhiot, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to workshop operation.

One delegation was received.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
