

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, February 10, 2022 at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with 2 councillors absent and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 10:05 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on January 13th, 2022 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of January was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Request for proposals were reviewed for the RM's diesel fuel supply and council accepted an RFP for the April 1, 2022 to March 31, 2023 period. Tenders were opened for the 2022 gravel loading, hauling and spreading and awarded to 2 companies. Council authorized a tender for the grading and clay cap of approximately 6.4 kilometers of municipal road as well as for the pasture land for lease located at NW 19-05-33 W1.

Council authorized the contract and construction of a cold storage shed and authorized the purchase of a new crew cab truck. Purchase of a trailer for the Alida Fire Department was also authorized. A lease agreement was also signed with the Village of Alida.

Voting delegates for the 2022 SARM Convention and SMHIA Meeting were appointed. Council authorized a donation to SERF and approved the Draft Auditor's Report and the Draft Financial Statements for 2021. Council also authorized the Public Works Foreman to recall seasonal employees at his discretion and authorized the offering of a dust control program using Fusion Dust Control.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

One delegation was received via electronic means.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

Due to loss of quorum, the meeting was adjourned at 2:00 p.m.
