

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, April 13, 2023, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all Councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on March 9th, 2023, were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of March was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council signed off on a property damage release and authorized the purchase of a Case IH tractor & loader and a Can-Am Defender. The meeting was suspended for the purpose of a public hearing for Bylaw No. 6-23 Official Community Plan Amending Bylaw and Bylaw No. 7-23 Zoning Bylaw Amending Bylaw. There were no members of the public present and there were no written representations to present. Bylaws 6-23, 7-23, and 8-23 were passed.

Council acknowledged receipt of a road ban order, approved the SMHIA withdrawal list, and accepted the 2023 school mill rates established by the Province of Saskatchewan. A third-party investigator was appointed and contributions to the Alameda 4H Show & Sale and the Alida Rec Board Online Auction were authorized.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop.

Four delegations were received.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 5:15 p.m.
