

MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, February 9, 2023, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with all Councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 10:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on January 12th, 2023, were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of January was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council signed a final Proof of Loss with SARM. Request for proposals were reviewed for the RM's diesel fuel supply and council accepted an RFP for the April 1, 2023 to March 31, 2024 period. Tenders were opened for the 2023 gravel loading, hauling and spreading and awarded to 2 companies. Council increased gravel royalty rates and authorized the advertising to receive applications for two seasonal employees. Council approved the Draft Auditor's Report and the Draft Financial Statements for 2022. Voting delegates for the 2023 SARM Convention and SMHIA Meeting were appointed. Readings were completed on three bylaws. Council replaced two yield signs in the municipality with stop signs and will again offer a cost-shared dust control program for 2023.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop.

One delegation was received to discuss gravel.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 4:10 p.m.
